


EXECUTIVE DIRECTOR'S REPORT

District Meeting October 6, 2016

1. Request for Urban Expansion – The IMC met October 3, 2016 to review studies required by the MOU. A decision on May 6 requested that VBJ amend their application to include only the 50-acre commercial parcel to which VBJ has concerns. The IMC has requested VBJ to present the drainage report and the proposed residential development plan to determine if a water management program satisfactory to Cornwallis and Brandon is planned, and discuss mitigation. As drainage issues affect the District as a whole, each Director has received an invitation to the meeting scheduled.
2. The Inter Municipal committee met July 14th regarding the Joint Planning Area Communication Policy. With the results of the groups discussions and input, I prepared a draft for staff to review. Staff have completed their review and a draft policy will be circulated to the IMC for final review and recommendation to come before the Board for approval.
3. Progress is being made on the enforcement clause of the Inspection Services Agreement. Final edits are being reviewed by Greg Tramley and Bob Patterson. As the Service Delivery and Rural Services agreement drafts were finalized early this year, I hope to have the three agreements signed at our December meeting.
4. Development Plan Amendment By-law 107/02/16 (McLeod) Public Hearing will be held November 3, 2016 at 7:00 pm at the Cornwallis Council Chambers. Our regular meeting will be re-scheduled from 1:30 pm that day and will commence following the public hearing.
